Homework

- Homework usually falls into one of three categories: practice, preparation, or extension.
- Students should expect to have homework
- Students who miss homework because of absence will receive the opportunity to make up missed work within a reasonable amount of time set by the teacher
- If a student does not turn in an assignment on the due date, the teacher will enter a "M" in the grade book
- While late homework assignments will be accepted, full credit will not be awarded
- Homework that is obviously copied will result in a grade of 0 for the persons involved
- Individuals with extenuating circumstances will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis
- Homework is 10% of the quarter grade

Late Work

- If a student does not turn in an assignment by the due date, the teacher will enter a "M" in the grade book
- While late assignments will be accepted, students who are tardy in their submission will be charged a 10% late fee
- This fee does not grow with the number of days it takes to complete the work
- Individuals with extenuating circumstances will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis

Explanation of Zeroes

- Teacher will refrain from initially assigning a zero for work that is missing
- A “M” will be put into the grade book meaning the assignment is missing or has not been turned in
- Efforts will be made to hold student accountable for completing missing work before assigning a zero
- Teacher will use discretion for exceptions for extenuating circumstances
- Students who exhibit a chronic pattern of behavior around missing work will receive a referral for support services

Reassessment

- A student shall be permitted to retake any major assessment he or she has failed within five school days of the date the failing grade was passed back
- Students must follow the retake process outlined below to take a reassessment
- A written request by the student, including an explanation for requesting the retake
- The student’s demonstration of effort to attain mastery learning, which includes a mandatory outside of class tutoring/test corrections session and all classwork/homework needs to have been completed and turned in on time.
- The student must arrange with the teacher for a retake
- If the test is passed on the second attempt, the failing grade shall be removed from the grade book, and the higher grade recorded where the maximum attainable grade will be a 75%
- End-of-semester exams cannot be retaken

Make-up Work

- The timely completion of assignments is expected
- Students will be given the opportunity to make up work for all excused and verified absences
- Immediately upon returning to school, the student must contact teachers concerning arrangements for making up work
- Work missed should be made up within the number of school days the student was absent from school

- Work turned in after the allotted number of school days may receive a reduction in grade
- Under extenuating circumstances, the due date for this work may be adjusted at the discretion of the teacher
- An assignment given to a student for make-up purposes will be given full credit provided it satisfies the conditions for make-up work

Extra Credit

- Academic extra credit will not be given as a separate assignment
- No extra academic credit will be given for bringing supplies, canned goods, or other items not associated with course and curricular objectives
