Homework

Students will be responsible for the completion of their homework tasks; the homework grades will make up no more than 10% of their final quarter grade.

Late Work

LATE WORK WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. It is the responsibility of each student to make sure that her/his work is submitted on the due date which the instructor sets. Failure to turn in any work on time will result in the loss of the grade for that assignment. Should a student be absent on the day an assignment is due, it is the responsibility of that student to make sure that her/his work is turned in to the instructor prior to the absence or by a responsible courier; most work will be turned in digitally, however, so absence will not be an excuse. Regardless of which delivery method you choose, the assignment must be delivered **PRIOR** to when it is due, not after. If I can't open and/or read your document, then it is as if you didn't bother to submit it, so make sure you save your documents, attach them properly, and submit them on time.

Explanation of Zeroes

Students receive zeroes for work that was never received or completed.

Reassessment

Students will be allowed to conference in order to revise essays or other formally completed writing. A conference prior to submission is required. Other work is process-based and cannot be reassessed as a result.

Make-up Work

Students are responsible for following the unit and year plans provided for them. Students must seek information via Google Classroom and communication with the teacher in order to receive and complete make-up work. Absence is not an excuse for incomplete work; extenuating circumstances will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
