WHEN?

Tuesday August 23rd-Thursday August 25th; 8:30am-11:30am

WHERE?

At each of our four elementary schools

WHAT?

Each day will include circle time, academic exploration, story time, free play, and outdoor time with peers.



NOTE: All children must be **fully** registered for Kindergarten in order to participate in this program (see list on the right).

NOTE: Additional student services will **not** be offered during this time. Also, nurses will **not** be on site during this time.

As a reminder, here is our Kindergarten Document checklist

1. **START HERE:** eRegistration [form](#)
2. Locator Card from Town Hall-Signed original
3. Child's Birth Certificate, adoption decree or passport
4. Current record of immunizations signed by a physician. (Except for medical or religious reasons, State Law requires that students must be properly immunized before they can attend school.)
5. Evidence of child's most recent physical exam, Dental Exam and lead screening date and results.
6. A certified copy of the most recent court order identifying each parent's respective award of physical custody, if applicable.
7. A copy of the students' IEP or 504 plan, if applicable.
8. Copies of parent/guardian licenses (front and back)
