Subject(s): Fine Arts - Visual Arts

Grade Level: 9-12

Homework

Homework consists of but is not limited to written tasks, drawings, skill practice, and various other assignments (Usually involving the sketchbook)

A 5 percentage point deduction will be assigned for each class period that it is late. After two weeks (5 class -periods), student can earn back 50% upon completion of assignment.

Late Work

After two weeks, parent contact to alert them of situation and students still may earn up to 90% of their grade upon full completion

Student must turn in ALL late and/or re-submitted projects one week prior to the end of the quarter.

Explanation of Zeroes

Failure to submit or refusal to do work will result in an initial zero being entered into the gradebook.

All work must be submitted by the quarterly re-submission date for a grade or the zero will remain.

Reassessment

After two weeks student still may earn up to 90% of their grade upon full completion

Students who are unhappy with their project grade WHEN SUBMITTED ON TIME, may re-submit their artwork for up to 100% of their grade after reworking the original submitted project

Student must turn in all late and/or re-submitted projects one week prior to the end of the quarter.

Make-up Work

A 5 percentage point deduction will be assigned for each class period that it is late. After two weeks (5 class -periods), student can earn back 50% upon completion of assignment.

Can receive an immediate academic detention if homework is essential for the class and not completed after 1 week in order to make up for lost in class time spent on completing assignment. Students are notified when such an assignment is given.

Extra Credit

Extra credit is not given in visual arts
