Subject(s): Health and Physical Education Level I

### Homework

**All work is expected to be completed in class. If a student does not complete the work during the class period, they will complete it for Homework. No specific homework will be assigned daily. Classwork is 12% of the Final Grade.**

### Late Work

**All late work will be accepted. The allotted points will be deducted depending on how late the work is turned in. 10 points are deducted for each day the work is turned in late.**

### Explanation of Zeroes

**Any work not turned in will be marked with a zero. All students have the opportunity to receive a grade for their work when completed and turned in. The appropriate points will be deducted depending on when the work is turned in.**

### Reassessment

**Students will have the opportunity to retake a test or quiz. To be make up by the end of rotation cycle; which is a 2 week rotation.**

### Make-up Work

**Students have the opportunity to turn in any missed assignments for full credit by the end of the Health Rotation. After the allotted Health Rotation, the assignment will be late and 10 points per day will be deducted according to when it was turned in.**

### Extra Credit

**There will be opportunities for extra credit. Extra credit points will be used in a "Bank Like" fashion. A student can choose to use all or some of their extra credit points on an assignment, quiz or test. Extra Credit points will most commonly be added to a Test Grade.**
