



## Grading Practices

Subject(s): **Academic Concepts**

Grade Level: **9-12**

### Homework

Homework is no more than 10% of the grade and is used to support organizational skills and core subject areas.

### Late Work

Students receive a “Z” until late work is submitted. Students are expected to complete the assignment on the date assigned, however deadlines may be adjusted at teacher discretion based on individual circumstances

### Explanation of Zeroes

A “Z” is assigned to all missing work. If work is not submitted within five days of the close of a grading period, a 50% will be assigned and the work will be noted as “not submitted” in the public notes section of the grade book.

### Reassessment

Any student who earns a failing grade on a summative assessment (to include a unit test, end of quarter test, major projects or papers), may be given an opportunity for reassessment provided the student has participated in class, completed related assignments, and demonstrated his/her best effort to meet with success on the prior assessment.

### Make-up Work

If a student misses a classwork assignment due to absence, an alternate assignment may be given. Due dates for make-up work is at the teacher’s discretion.

### Extra Credit

There is no extra credit offered.
