Homework

Homework will not exceed 10% of a student's grade.

Late Work

Late work will be accepted for reduced credit within the current unit prior to the end of the grading period.

Explanation of Zeroes

Zeros will be given for work not completed. Work is considered "not completed" when the late work period described above is exceeded. Until then, it will be considered Missing Work.

Reassessment

Reassessment will be available for students who earned a failing grade on an assessment. For students who earned a grade 50% or less on an assessment, the reassessment will be mandatory. Reassessments must be completed within one week of the original assessment.

Make-up Work

Make-up work for excused absences is the responsibility of the student and should be completed within 3 school days

Extra Credit

When offered, extra credit will be available to all students and will be connected to the curriculum/unit of study.
