Homework

Homework is given as needed to reinforce or review a skill; it is not given on a daily or weekly basis. Homework may not exceed 10% of a student's grade.

Late Work

Late work will be accepted for reduced credit within the current unit prior to the end of the grading period.

Explanation of Zeroes

Zeros are assigned when work is due and not turned in by the end of the quarter. The late work policy will be in effect.

Reassessment

Students will have the opportunity to retake failing assessment one additional time and the higher grade will be recorded in the gradebook. Students must initiate the scheduling of the makeup assessment within one week of the initial assessment.

Make-up Work

All class assignments are to be made up within one calendar week of an absence. In the event a student misses a test or a quiz, it must be made up within 3 days of an absence. If a student is going to be absent for several days, they may get their assignments in advance.

Extra Credit

When offered, extra credit will be available to all students and will be connected to the curriculum/unit of study.
