

# Grading Practices

School: Salem High School.

Subject(s): VPAA Chorus.

Grade Level: VPAA 9-12

## Homework

Homework/Practice Assignments may not exceed 10% of a student's grade.

Performances are different from homework and will be weighted at 50%. A make-up assignment is offered for excused performance absences but it is only 75% the value of the concert.

## Late Work

Late work will be accepted for reduced credit. The reduction will be 10% per class meeting, bottoming out at 50%.

Late work will not be accepted after 2 weeks past the due date or beyond a grading (report card) deadline.

Excused illness is an exception to the above.

## Explanation of Zeroes

A "0" placeholder will be inserted until the assignment is made up in accordance with SHS policy

Or

Zeros will be given when work not turned in by end of grading period.

## Reassessment

Reassessments may be offered for homework and classwork, but only if all required classwork and homework for the relevant assignment have been completed. No reassessments will not be offered for quizzes and tests.

## Make-up Work

Completing and submitting make-up work is the student's responsibility..

The make-up assignment for an excused absence from a performance: 1) the student's recording of their part on performance repertoire, and 2) a five page report on a topic to be assigned. Students have 2 (two) weeks after the missed performance to submit the make-up assignment at full credit. unexcused absences will not be eligible for the make-up assignment; a zero will be assigned for the performance.

## Extra Credit

In accordance with SHS policy, extra credit will not be offered.
