Subject(s): VPAA Visual Arts

Grade Level: 9-12

Homework

- Homework will not be worth more than 10% of the student's grade.

Late Work

- For projects and classwork, partial credit **up to 50%** can be given for work done during class time witnessed by teacher when the project is not turned-in by the original due date.
- For Homework, students have two school days from the time of the missed assignment to submit with a 10% reduction per day after which the assignment will no longer be accepted for grading.

Explanation of Zeroes

- Failure to submit or refusal to do work will result in an initial zero being entered into the gradebook.
- All work must be submitted by the quarterly re-submission date for a grade or the zero will remain.

Reassessment

- For projects and classwork, students who have submitted on time may re-submit their artwork after improvements for up to 100% of their grade if submitted by the quarterly re-submission date.
- Homework may not be resubmitted for improved grade but may be resubmitted for feedback.

Make-up Work

- For projects, homework or classwork: Relevant and equivalent make-up work is assigned to an approved absent student next class due the following class period.
- For Sketchbooks: Students have two school days from the time of the missed assignment to submit with a 10% reduction per day after which the assignment will no longer be accepted for grading.
- For Projects, failure to submit will result in an after school academic detention where students may earn up to 90% of their grade upon submission of their missing work.

Extra Credit

Extra credit is not given in VPAA visual arts
