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PBIS - Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports

Students have been provided training on the behavioral expectations in all common areas (classroom, hallway, cafeteria, playground, and bathroom). Students are also provided daily reminders of expectations on the morning announcements. Staff provide Bobcat Bucks to our students who are "caught" following expectations in the common areas. Bobcat Bucks are then turned into a central location and during the Monday morning weekly announcements, Bobcat Bucks are drawn to recognize the winners. There is one female and one male from each grade level chosen weekly. We have some pretty cool PBIS prizes from which the students may choose.



A FEW REMINDERS:

- Please make sure students have a water bottle at school so that they can stay hydrated throughout the school day.
- Students should be dressing appropriately for the weather - if temperatures are too low, students are kept inside during recess time.
