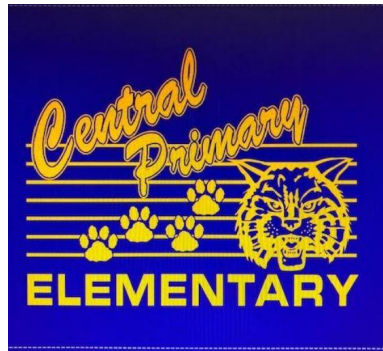
Every Minute Counts!

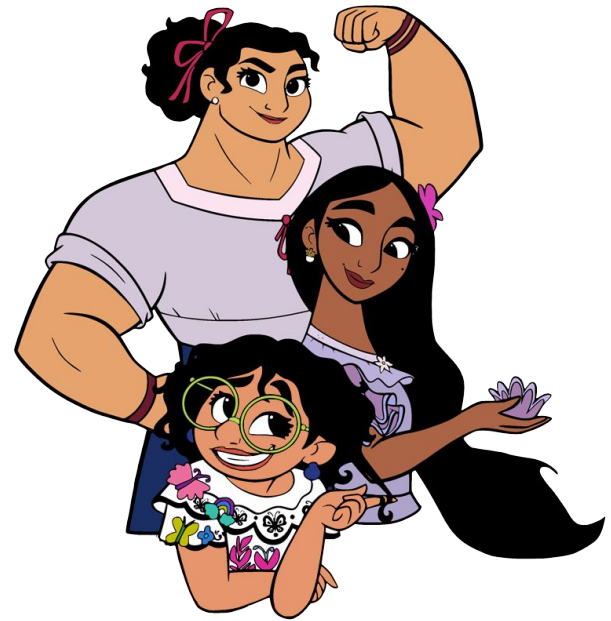
