Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Bloomfield Early Childhood Center will be moving to a temporary remote setting due to high transmission rates of Covid-19, influenza, and RSV in our classrooms. Kindergarten students will return to school on November 28 and Preschool students will return on November 29.

The decision to move to remote learning was made to keep students and staff safe and stop the spread of these illnesses. This action will allow our custodial crew to complete deep cleaning and proper sanitization.

All close contacts who need to quarantine per the requirements outlined in the NMPED/NMDOH COVID-19 Response ToolKit for Public Schools have been notified of their quarantine dates. If you have not been notified, your student does not need to quarantine at this time. *Per health staff, if your student(s) experience any COVID-19, influenza, or RSV symptoms, please see your Primary Healthcare Provider or visit an area urgent care. Common symptoms of all include: coughing, fatigue, fever, runny nose, sore throat, decreased appetite, nausea and headache.*

Classroom teachers will send an email to remind all families how students can access learning during this temporary closure.
