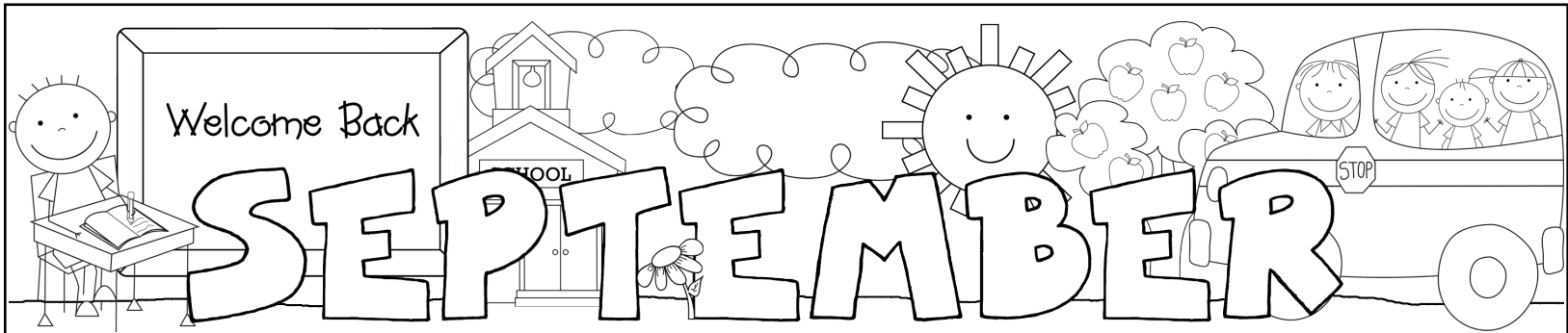

Attendance

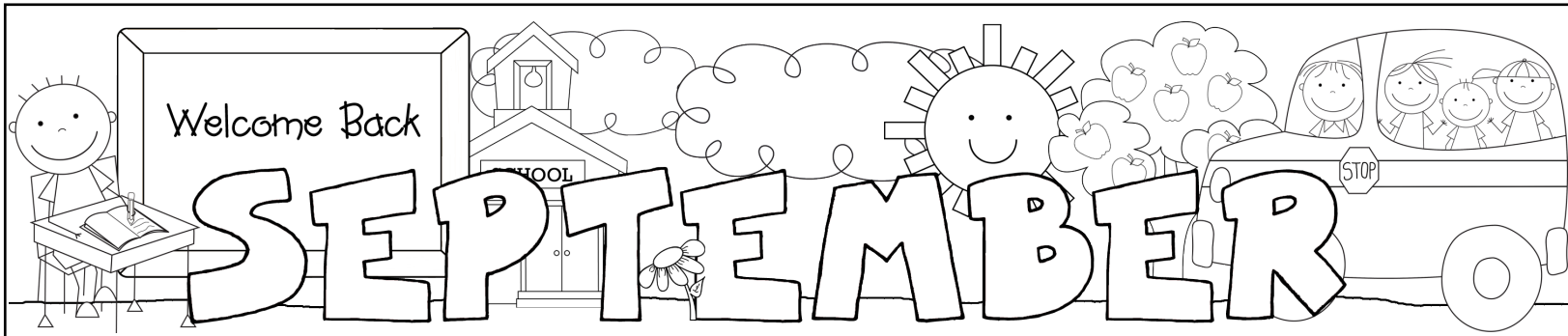
School attendance is important for student academic success.
