Skyward

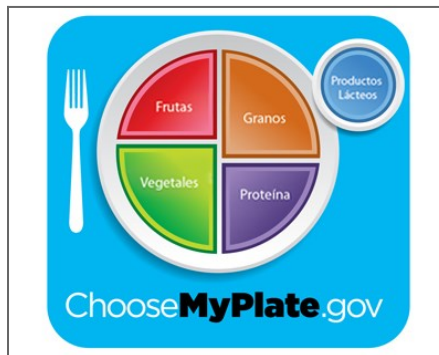
Every student has a cafeteria account. Parents/guardians can look up their child's **cafeteria account balance** and **meal statement** in [Skyward Family Access](#). They may also look up recent spending activities and set an a la Carte spending limit.

The District sends emails and makes robo calls to notify parents/guardians when their child has a negative account balance. While Tahoma Nutrition Services will make every effort to notify the parent/guardian when a student has insufficient funds to purchase school meals, it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to monitor the student's account balance and ensure that funds are available by prepaying for school meals or sending a cash or check payment with their student. Families may also consider completing an **application for free and reduced priced meals** at any time throughout the school year.

Food Allergy Information

If your child has a food allergy and you would like to have a substitution made during breakfast or lunch, please turn in a doctor's note to the school nurse or Tahoma Nutrition Services. For those families managing peanut/nut allergies, you will be pleased to know that we do not serve any peanut butter /peanuts/ nuts at breakfast and lunch.
