There is a zero period Orchestra class that can be added to make this a .8 FTE position Teaching related skill development in alignment with the Common Core State Standards will be required. Diversified learning experiences will be expected and instruction directed at individual student strengths and areas of growth will be demonstrated by the successful candidate. Demonstrated skill in the teaching of Music is required. The successful candidate will be provided opportunity to be fully involved with the elementary, secondary, and district staff and a commitment to meaningful collaboration is desired.

- Knowledge and understanding of learning and teaching philosophy and the developmental needs of students.
- Successful experience working with a wide range of student abilities, both academically and socially, including at-risk students, students with special needs, and independent learners.
- Evidence of strong, positive student management.
- Ability to use a variety of assessments to inform instruction.
- Commitment to establishing effective, proactive and positive parent communication.
- Participate in district efforts toward continuous improvement.
- Ability to develop, monitor and assess independent learning contracts, learning packets, etc.
- Understanding of the unique needs and opportunities presented by creative and independent minded students.
- Evidence of diversified teaching background and subject-matter adaptability.
