

In the past, GCSD has had to cancel school due to inclement weather, flooding, or hurricanes. The establishment of district-wide eLearning Days, when applicable, ensures student safety while preventing gaps in learning and helps avoid rescheduling make-up days. On eLearning Days teachers and students do not report physically to school. Asynchronous school work is assigned and completed during these days. Students completing this work are marked as present. This prevents a lapse in learning and counts as a day of school.

eLEARNING

- Students are expected to complete asynchronous assignments assigned by their teacher(s).
- Students in grades Pre-K-2 will receive paper packets or Seesaw assignments to complete.
- Students in grades 3-12 will be assigned lessons through Google Classroom.
- All assignments must be completed within 3 days of returning to school in order for students to be marked present on e-learning days.
