WACCAMAW HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT PARKING LOT AND DRIVING PRIVILEGES:

- Students MUST provide proof of driver's license at time of purchase for parking spot.
- Students should exit their vehicles once parked and enter the building.
- Students are NOT ALLOWED to leave campus without permission from an ADMINISTRATOR or the FRONT OFFICE once arriving on campus.
- Students should NOT be in the student parking lot during the day unless they have been approved to do so with a pass from the ADMINISTRATION.
- If a student drives to school a student MUST hold a legal driver's license (not Permit) to operate a motor vehicle on campus and MUST purchase a school parking permit. The permit MUST be displayed at all times while on campus.
- Anyone carelessly or recklessly operating their vehicles are subject to a fine from law enforcement and/or will have their driving privileges suspended at the discretion of the administration.
- Students are to park in their Designated Parking Spot ONLY. Students should not park in the front of the school, or in the back BUS Parking area.
- I understand that the parking lot is public property and according to the law, persons and the vehicles of persons on campus are subject to search.
- Students parking in unauthorized areas are subject to being towed at owner's expense.
- Repeated tardiness to school will result in suspension of driving privileges at the discretion of the administration.
