Departmental Goals 2022-2023

1	<i>Math</i>	By June 2023, K-5 students that are non-proficient in the area of problem-solving will close their proficiency gap by 50%.
2	<i>ELA</i>	All students in grades 6-8 will score a 3 or 4 using the NJSLA Rubric for Narrative Task in ELA classes by May 30, 2023.
3	<i>Science</i>	All K-6 science students will close their proficiency gap in the area of science concepts and on the science, writing benchmarks by 50% or achieve proficiency by June 2023.
4	<i>Pre-School</i>	To decrease writing nonproficiency of four-year-old students from 18% to 9% by June 15, 2023
5	<i>Special Education</i>	By June 30, 2023, 40% of classified students will be moved to a less restrictive environment.
6	<i>Student Services</i>	Student attendance will improve by 50% for SY 2023 as compared to SY 2022, by June 30, 2023
7	<i>Principals</i>	TMES: By June 30, 2023, Thurgood Marshall Elementary School will double the level of grade-level proficiency on informative writing benchmarks in grades 1-3, based on SY 21-22 baseline data. APHS: By August of 2023, Asbury Park High School will reduce the historic instances of credit recovery for graduation requirements by 75%. MLKUES: By June 30, 2023, students scoring a 3 or better on the research simulation task (RST) writing rubric will double last year's EoY mark
8	<i>Athletics</i>	By June 2023, the Athletic Department will increase student athlete eligibility by 50% in grade 7th through 12th grades.
9	<i>Human Resources</i>	By June 2023, 95% of the Asbury Park Staff will fall in the 95th percentile for occasional absence.
10	<i>Security</i>	By June 23, 2023, we will establish updated emergency responses SOP's that will be shared with staff and community.
11	<i>Buildings & Grounds</i>	Reduce by 50% the number of unsatisfied rated support requests received from SchoolDude for the Top 3 categories by June 30, 2023.
12	<i>Information Technology</i>	Improve end-to-end transparency and accountability between customers and the IT Department by reducing the top two School Dude requests by 50%.
13	<i>Grants</i>	Spend 90% of Our State Grant Allocations by the end of September 2023
14	<i>Superintendent's Office</i>	By June 30, 2023, The Superintendent's Office will have improved the Central Office Workplace Culture by 50%.
