As a reminder, we are closely monitoring our daily attendance rates for all our schools. Our goal is to make sure that we are arriving to school on time. So far, each school is making progress and working collaboratively with our attendance officers in an effort to encourage students to be prompt and present for school. As you know, school attendance is vital to the success of every student. Students who attend school regularly have been shown to have higher grades and be more successful into adulthood. Our daily attendance goal daily is 95% or greater for both students and staff, and we need your support.

Finally, we began our after-school program on Oct. 24 for grades kindergarten through 6th. The hours of operation are 2:45 to 5:15 p.m. Monday through Friday. In addition, we offer a credit recovery program for high school students that will focus on ensuring we are working with those students to meet graduation requirements and succeed academically.
