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Notificaciones para los Padres de Pruebas/evaluaciones Planeadas por el Departamento del Estado de New Jersey para el Año Escolar del 2021-2022

Queridos Padres y/o Representantes,

De acuerdo a N.J.S.A. 18A:7C-6.6, los distritos escolares están requeridos a proveer notificación de información a los padres/representantes sobre las pruebas/evaluaciones estatales o evaluaciones comerciales estandarizadas de desarrollo que serán administrados a los estudiantes durante el año escolar. Es importante notar que no todas las pruebas/evaluaciones serán administradas a todos los estudiantes.

Específicamente, estamos obligados a compartir lo siguiente:

- Evaluación de áreas temáticas y nivel de grado cubierto por la prueba/examen;
- La fecha o rangos de fechas para administrar las evaluaciones;
- El tiempo asignado para que los estudiantes tomen y completan la evaluación;
- Cualquier modificación especial y opción de accesibilidad disponible a los estudiantes;
- Información sobre y cómo el estudiante y su padre/representante o guardián puede tener acceso ambas preguntas de ejemplo y respuestas de la evaluación y resultados del estudiante; y
- Si la evaluación es requerida por el Estado o el gobierno federal, o ambos.

En respuesta a los requerimientos mencionados arriba, observen en la lista de abajo el calendario de plantilla que cumple con todo el criterio de las evaluaciones planeadas que nuestro distrito va a implementar durante el próximo año escolar. Por favor, note que nuestro distrito ofrece una variedad de modificaciones y opciones de acceso que van acorde a las necesidades individuales de su estudiante requeridas por la ley.
