













Good afternoon families,

Today was a great start to the 2021-22 school year. Students got to meet their teachers, see their friends, and figure out their new schedules. Below are just a few reminders.

Parent drop off and pick up is in the small parking lot near the gymnasium. Students will be asked to wait on the side walk. You may drive up to the curb or stand on the grassy island in the parking lot. Staff will cross students to parents waiting in the parking lot. Students should not cross alone. We also ask parents not to walk over to the side walk for purposes of Covid safety. Please do not enter the bus circle before 8:00am or between 2:30pm and 2:45pm. You may get stuck between the buses and it creates an unsafe situation.

Please remind students to charge their Chromebooks each night.

All students may wear their own masks, but they must meet CDC recommendations and should include a metal piece in the top to fit it around the nose. Please see the chart below. You can find this information, as well as the district Covid protocols, on the district website.

Hoy fue un gran comienzo para el año escolar 2021-22. Los estudiantes pudieron conocer a sus maestros, ver a sus amigos y descubrir sus nuevos horarios. A continuación se muestran algunos recordatorios.

Para dejar y recoger a los padres en el pequeño estacionamiento cerca del gimnasio. Se les pedirá a los estudiantes que esperen en la acera. Puede conducir hasta la acera o pararse en la isla cubierta de hierba en el estacionamiento. El personal cruzará a los estudiantes con los padres que esperan en el estacionamiento.
