POLICY ON STUDENT-ATHLETE SOCIAL NETWORKING AND MEDIA USE

Student-athletes at Wachusett Regional High School are representatives of our high school and community. Students are reminded to use good judgment in their use of social media, and to be respectful and responsible when engaging in these activities.

Best Practices and Reminders:

- Think twice before posting. If you wouldn't want your coach, parents or future employer to see your post, don't post it.
- Be respectful and positive
- Everything you post is public information, even if you limit access to your site
- What you post may affect your future. Many college admissions and intercollegiate athletics personnel, as well as employers, review social networking sites as part of their overall evaluation of an applicant.

The Wachusett Department of Athletics will not tolerate disrespectful comments or behavior online. Violation of the Student-Athlete Social Media Policy may result in disciplinary action, including temporary or permanent suspension from the team, as determined by the principal, athletic director and head coach.
