Explanation

Crete High School activities are included in the negotiated agreement, which requires approval by the CPS Board of Education.

Crete High School activities are often chartered by sanctioning organizations that govern with rules and bylaws, and may charge membership dues and fees. Examples include, Crete FFA Chapter chartered by the National FFA Organization and volleyball sanctioned by the Nebraska Schools Activities Association.

CCLC activities are a part of the grant funded out-of-school time site program, which only requires approval by CCLC administration.

CCLC is free of cost. The activities are not chartered, however CCLC regularly serves an incubator, or a trial run, for activities seeking a potential charter from a sanctioning organization and/or future approval for inclusion in the negotiated agreement.
