Family participation is essential. The afterschool program remains *free of charge* and open to all K-12 students if stakeholders are active, well-informed, and public champions.



A network of local partners (private businesses, nonprofits, public agencies, etc.) volunteer their time, contribute in-kind donations, and provide matching funds for grants.



In addition to limited-term federal and state grants, CCLC seeks public and private grants to supplement funding.

Note: Government grants mandate Student Attendance Goals and Programming Expectations, which include maintaining specific enrollment percentages of underserved populations.
