

Asbestos Management Plan Notification

The US EPA published their AHERA (Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act) Regulations in 1986. The federal regulation required that all local education agencies (LEA's) have their buildings inspected for asbestos-containing building materials (ACBM), to have a written Asbestos Management Plan developed, and to institute an Asbestos Operations and Maintenance (O&M) Program to train in-house personnel how to properly manage and work around the ACBM in their buildings. This notification serves as the annual notification which is required to be sent to all school district employees, parents, groups and organizations to explain the Management Plans and any current relevant activities. The purpose of this Annual Notification is to explain the status and availability of the Asbestos Management Plan, to review recent asbestos-related activities in the school district, and to list the asbestos-related activities that are planned to take place in the upcoming calendar year. The Management Plans are available for review in the main office at all school buildings and at the Board Office, 2803 South Banker Street, Effingham, IL 62401.
