POLICY SUBCOMMITTEE MEETING

Monday, January 13, 2014

A meeting of the Policy Subcommittee was held on Monday, January 13, 2014 at 5:30 pm in the 2nd Floor Conference Room at the NAGE Building. Mr. Bregoli called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm.

Mr. Bregoli reviewed the School Committee meeting calendar for 2014-2015, which had been referred at the January 8, 2014 School Committee meeting.

Mrs. Hubley made a motion to approve the School Committee meeting calendar for 2014-2015 as presented. Ms. Isola seconded the motion and on a voice vote, the ayes have it.

Mr. Bregoli reviewed the School Year Calendar for 2014-2015, which had been referred at the January 8, 2014 School Committee meeting.
