Background: This historic city on the coast bordering the south side of Boston has a balance of business, industrial and residential areas. Quincy is an average socio-economic community that values and supports quality education.

North Quincy High School serves the educational needs of Quincy's Wollaston and North Quincy neighborhoods. North Quincy High School is one of city's two high schools. Families from all of Quincy's neighborhoods have the option of enrolling their students at North Quincy High School under the current "open enrollment" policy. Currently, the district consists of two high schools, five middle schools, and eleven elementary schools. **The student body is culturally diverse with a population that is 3.8% African-American, 53.5% Asian, 4.4% Hispanic, .3% Native American, 34.2% White, .3% Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander and 3.6% Multi-Race/Non-Hispanic.**

North Quincy High School

North Quincy High School is a comprehensive four-year public high school enrolling 1356 students in grades 9 through 12. The school opened in 1926 as North Junior High and gradually added upper grades, graduating its first senior class in 1934. North Quincy High School is accredited by New England Association of Secondary Schools (NEASC) and holds membership in the National Association for College Admission Counseling and New England Association of College Admission Counseling.

Curriculum

The academic program is organized on a rotating 1-block period schedule. Students are required to take a minimum of six academic courses. Ability grouping: Advanced (A), Honors (H), College and Career Prep (CCP).

Term Three - For each course students received a grade for Term three that is either "received credit (RC)" or "received no credit (RNC)." Term four was canceled for this school year.

Final Grades - Students received final course grades that are reported as "received credit(RC)" or "received no credit (RNC)."

Full year courses - final grades of RC/RNC were based on the average of the grades for terms one, two, and three.

First semester courses – final grades of RC/RNC were based on grades from term one and two.

Second-semester courses - final grades of RC/RNC were based on grades from term three.

GPA – Term three grades are not calculated in the GPA. Terms one and two are included in the GPA.

GPA Calculation

GPA is based on the grade given in each course and the level of that course. All values are then added together and this total is divided by the number of courses taken (see table). Beginning with grade 9, all subjects, with the exception of physical education, whether passed or failed, are included in the computation. *Dual enrollment and credit recovery courses are not computed in rank or GPA calculation.*

Rank

Class rank is based on the weighted average of numeric grades earned for the current term and those earned in the previous terms starting with grade 9. (Class rank is determined by the student's weighted grade point average.)
