

# COVID-19 Testing Options

Are you in need of COVID-19 test? Please consider using one of the care options that best fits your needs below.

**Asymptomatic patients** are not experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms but have had **close contact or suspected exposure** to someone who does have symptoms. The PCR test is used in these cases with results available within 24 to 48 hours. **DO NOT** go to your local Emergency Department for a COVID-19 test.

- **\*Self-schedule a drive-up COVID-19 test at one of our OSF PromptCare locations** - You do not need to be an OSF HealthCare patient to schedule an appointment. Testing days and times vary at each of OSF PromptCare locations in Ottawa, Streator and Mendota. Go to your OSF MyChart account or follow this link to <https://www.osfhealthcare.org/covid19/about/testing/> to schedule your drive-up test online. Click on your testing location, day and appointment time.
- **\*OSF OnCall Urgent Care in Ottawa and Morris** - OSF OnCall Urgent Care locations will see walk-in patients 7 days a week between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. Schedule an online appointment by following this link <https://www.osfhealthcare.org/oncall/urgent-care/>. The appropriate COVID-19 test will be ordered at the time of your medical screening.

\* Due to COVID-19 testing demands, we are unable to accommodate travel and mandated workplace tests. See the resources listed below.

**Symptomatic patients** have symptoms that include: fever or chills, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, cough, fatigue and/or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea, vomiting or diarrhea.

- **Self-schedule a drive-up COVID-19 test at one of our OSF PromptCare locations** - You do not need to be an OSF HealthCare patient to schedule an appointment. Testing days and times vary at each of OSF PromptCare locations in Ottawa, Streator and Mendota. Go to your OSF MyChart account or follow this link to <https://www.osfhealthcare.org/covid19/about/testing/> to schedule your drive-up test online. Click on your testing location, day and appointment time.
- **OSF PromptCare locations** – Walk-in symptomatic patients will receive a medical screening along with a COVID-19 test. OSF PromptCare - Ottawa, 7 days, 8 a.m. – 8 p.m., OSF PromptCare - Streator, M-F, 8 a.m. - 6 p.m. & OSF PromptCare - Mendota, M-F, 8 am. – 5 p.m.
- **OSF OnCall Urgent Care in Ottawa and Morris** - OSF OnCall Urgent Care locations will see walk-in patients 7 days a week between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. Schedule an online appointment by following this link <https://www.osfhealthcare.org/oncall/urgent-care/>. The appropriate COVID-19 test will be ordered at the time of your medical screening.
- **OSF Medical Group** - Contact your OSF Primary Care Provider Office.
- **Emergency Department** - Go to your nearest OSF Emergency Department if your symptoms are severe or worsening and a COVID-19 test will be performed during your medical exam.
