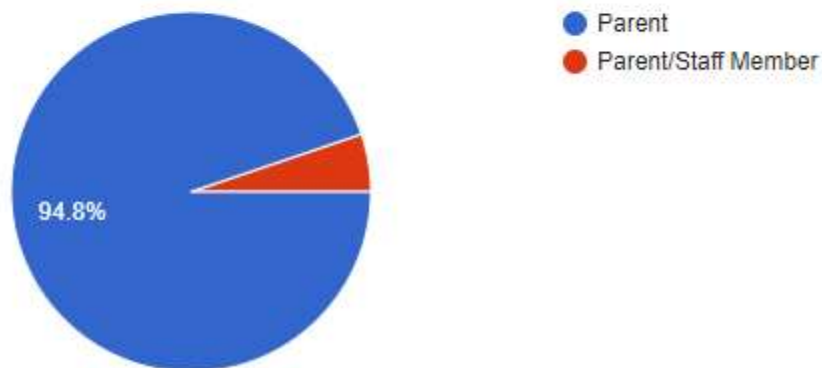

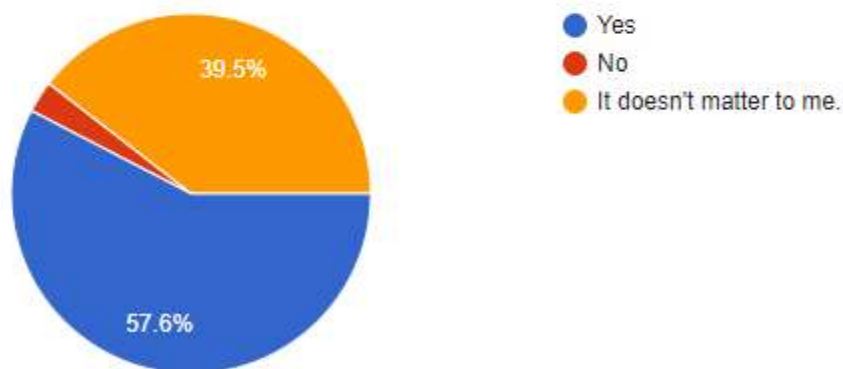

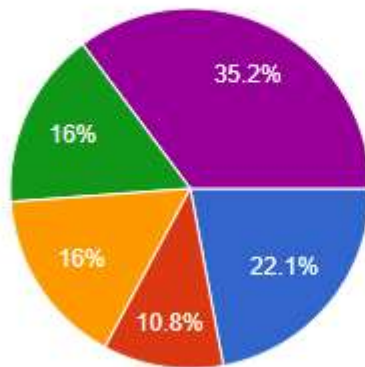
The most important thing to me is that the school year finishes before Memorial Day (assuming no emergency days).

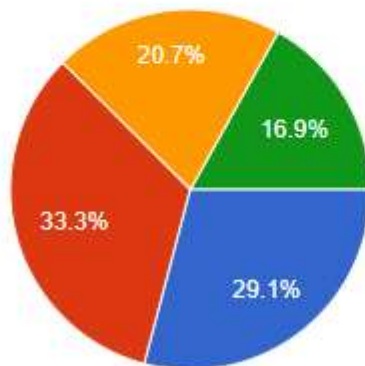

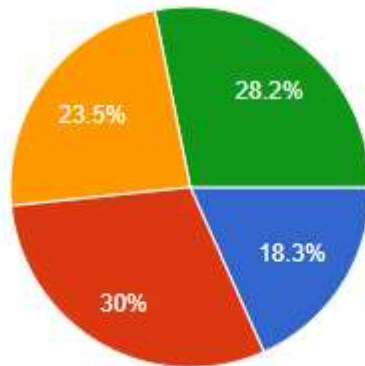
