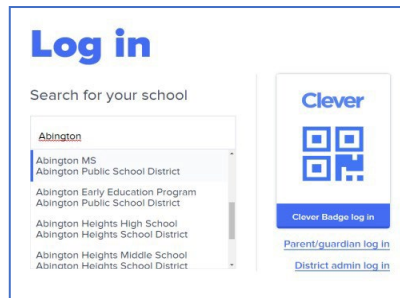

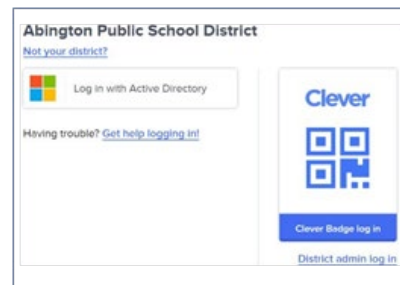

- Open a web browser (like Google Chrome, Edge, Firefox)
- Go to clever.com
- Click Log in as a student
- If you are prompted to search for your school, start typing the name of your school in field and it will pop up
- Click to select your school

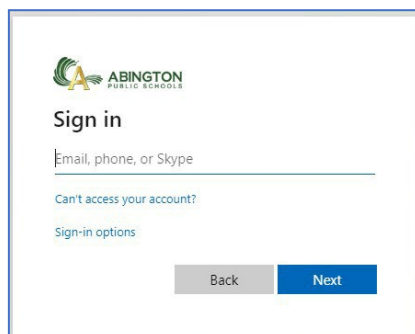


- Click Log in with Active Directory (K-2 students can also log on with their Clever badge, just choose Clever Badge log in)

- Sign in with your school email address and password (or Clever badge)

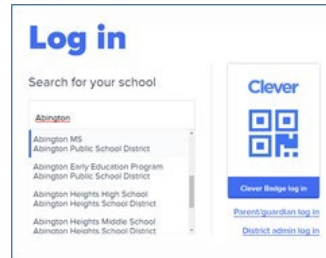


- Click on the icon for ST Math (Jiji the penguin)

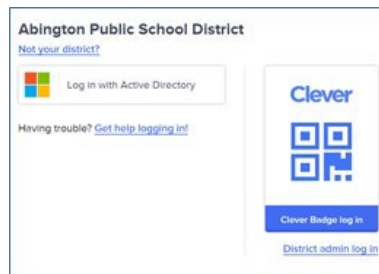

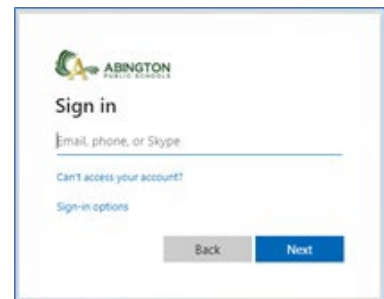

Get a set of flash cards. Test your addition and subtraction facts to 10.	Read a book about someone who is different from you.	Go to the grocery store. In your shopping cart, practice counting what you see. How many pieces of fruit? How many cans?	Read a book about Science.	Grab a handful of objects. (pennies, beads, marbles..) Guess how many there are. Count your objects. Were you close to your estimate?
Read a book about a real person.	Look at your toys. Try to sort them into 3 groups. How many toys are in each group?	Read a book that teaches you how to do something.	Explore STMath.com What math did you practice?	Read a book of poems.
Practice counting starting at a number other than one.	Read a book that teaches you about a place.	Keep track of the weather for 7 days. How many sunny days were there? Cloudy or rainy days?	Read a book that makes you laugh!	How many jumping jacks can you do in one minute?
Read a book about friendship.	Toss ten pennies. How many heads? How many tails? Try again! Did you get the same result?	Read a book that has won an award.	Make a picture using 2 circles, 3 triangles and 4 rectangles. Explain what it is and how you made it to someone.	Read a book about Summer!
Explore STMath.com What math did you practice?	Read a book that teaches you about an animal.	Describe two different ways to make 10 cents.	Read a book about an event in history.	Roll two dice and add the two numbers together. How many times did you have to roll to get a 12? Try again.
