



Expectations for Secondary

TEACHERS

- ◆ Create daily opportunities for meaningful engagement and collaboration with high quality, instruction that is grade/course appropriate
- ◆ Establish high expectations and clear learning objectives, prepare a variety of assignments and assessments, and provide timely feedback
- ◆ Provide real time instruction through Zoom or Google Meet, and proactively engage students in office hours
- ◆ Take daily attendance, provide letter grades, and utilize Canvas for each class
- ◆ Attend all PLC meetings and participate in professional development as needed

STUDENTS

- ◆ Attend classes every day, and actively participate in all lessons and activities, whether in person or virtually
- ◆ Complete assignments and assessments assigned by each teacher
- ◆ Log in to Canvas, and check school email daily; respond to all communication and feedback in a timely manner
- ◆ Contact teachers, counselors, and administrators for questions or assistance
- ◆ Follow the Academic Honesty Policy and Acceptable Use Policy as outlined in the Student Handbook

COUNSELORS

- ◆ Proactively support the academic, social-emotional, and college/career planning needs of all students
- ◆ Prioritize care and connection, and provide appropriate interventions, support, referrals, and resources to students in need
- ◆ Collaborate with teachers, parents, and administration to support students in the virtual teaching and learning environment

ADMINISTRATION

- ◆ Provide safe and healthy school environment with a daily learning schedule that allows students to pick up meals, if needed
- ◆ Promote high expectations for teaching and learning in Classic and Virtual classrooms
- ◆ Prioritize care and connection for all stakeholders
- ◆ Regularly communicate with the school community

SPECIAL EDUCATION

- ◆ Monitor student progress on IEP goals, and collaborate with general education teachers
- ◆ Provide FAPE and related services
- ◆ Provide high quality, real time support to students, and engage parents as partners

ENGLISH LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT

- ◆ Prioritize daily integrated and designated instruction for each student
- ◆ Monitor student learning in listening, reading, speaking, and writing, and provide targeted support and intervention as needed

PARENTS

- ◆ Create a learning space for your student(s), and ensure that student(s) have access to technology virtual schoolwork (Devices are available for student check-out from each school site.)
- ◆ Support student(s) in their daily organization, learning, and completion of assignments at home
- ◆ Respond to communication from the school, including the use of the learning management system called Canvas. (Ensure that contact information is provided on Parent Portal.)
- ◆ Participate in the Vista Institute for Parents for training and support
