FAQ: ACT/SAT Common Questions

- **Who needs to take the ACT/SAT?** Any student considering applying to a four year university should take at least one exam. Students registered with the NCAA should also take an exam. Students planning on applying to a UC campus should make sure they have taken their exams with the essay portion.
- **When do I register for the exam?** Juniors should consider taking at least one exam the spring/summer of their junior year. This allows enough time to review your scores and decide if you want to take a second exam in the fall of your senior year before applications are due. As soon as you are ready to commit to a test date and it is open for registration, you should register! Some dates and sites are more popular, so early registration guarantees you can your preferred test site. Sophomores and Juniors are recommended to take the PSAT in the fall.
