SENIORS:

Ready for the JC?

It's not too late to make sure you are ready for the SRJC next year.

Step #1

Submit Your Financial Aid Form

Miss the CA Priority deadline for FAFSA/CADAA? You can still file your financial aid form and be eligible for the Doyle and SRJC for Free tuition programs if you file this spring.

Step #2

Complete Spring & Fall Applications

Applying to the SRJC is free, but you do need to complete an application. Complete a spring application as a dual enrollment student so you can do the orientation class, and complete the fall application to take classes next year as a first-time college student.

Step #3

Register for Counseling 270

This spring seniors can take an orientation class to get ready for the SRJC and earn a higher priority registration date. You must submit a dual enrollment form to register for this class.

FAQ: Taking SRJC Summer Classes

- **Who can take classes at the SRJC?** Any student 14 years of age or older who has completed 8th grade can take classes as a dual enrollment student.
- **How many classes can I take?** High school students can enroll in up to 6 units in the summer term.
- **How do I sign up for a class?** Any high school student who wants to take a summer class at the SRJC must **complete the Summer 2020 online application.** Next, you must **meet with your RCHS counselor and get a dual enrollment form signed.** Finally, you will **register for your class on May 6th.**
- **How do I find the class schedule?** The summer schedule should be available by the end of March. This can be found at <https://classes.santarosa.edu/>. Choose "Summer 2020" on the drop down to see which classes will be offered.
