### WHAT:

The YMCA After School Education and Safety (ASES) Program provides education and recreation opportunities in a safe, productive environment for students during non-school hours. Children are also served a healthy snack every afternoon, which is provided through the Redwood Food Bank Supper Program.

### WHEN:

Monday through Friday, from school dismissal until 6pm.

### FEES:

ASES is the result of the 2002 voter approved initiative, Proposition 49. As a result, there is no cost to participate in this program.

### HOW TO REGISTER:

Registration for the 2016/2017 school year will take place on the following dates:

- April 30, 2016: 9:00 am, at Thomas Page Academy (This date is for children enrolling in or already enrolled in Thomas Page Academy).
- May 2, 2016: 6:30pm, at Waldo Rohnert Elementary (This date is for children enrolling in or already enrolled in John Reed or Waldo Rohnert elementary schools).
