Ross Short, Director of Career and Technical Education, gave an [update](#) on CTE programs offered at Port Susan MS, Stanwood MS, Lincoln Hill HS, and Stanwood HS. Twenty-nine percent of the Class of 2021 utilized the CTE Graduation Pathway.

Programs include Agriculture Education, Business and Marketing Education, Family and Consumer Sciences, Health Sciences, Skilled and Technical Sciences, Technology/STEM Education, and Visual Communications.
