Many students don't feel all adults hold students accountable for racist/cruel behavior (Student Survey January 2021)</p>	<p>SEL Behavior and insubordination referrals will decrease; all students will feel physically and emotionally safe to learn; students will understand their personal responsibility and role in developing a positive classroom culture by participating in developmentally appropriate classroom management.</p>	<p>SEL Refocus on 5 Non-negotiables and identify key “impermissibles” for staff to focus on as well; review discipline policy for each; train staff in writing referrals and assigning detention; consistently enforce discipline policy for the 5 Non-negotiables and key impermissibles. Collect classroom, class period, and small group data for behavior and insubordination referrals and detentions. Hire daily detention staff if data warrants increase and/or reinstate Saturday school. Use detentions to work on schoolwork. Staff in hallways during passing periods to monitor student behavior and build rapport.</p>	<p>SEL When students are behaving responsibly and contributing to a positive classroom culture, referrals and detention rates will decrease. Students can focus on learning better when they are not on cell phones for non-academic reasons; attendance and punctuality improve performance and help create a positive classroom culture that values learning; follow through on the impermissibles (i.e.no name calling) will help students feel safe and valued. Consistency across the school will help students navigate and participate in developmentally appropriate classroom management.</p>
