**PROHIBITION OF GENDER DISCRIMINATION  
IN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS**

No person in the Town of Webb Union Free School District shall, on the basis of either actual or perceived gender, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any educational program or activity which receives Federal financial assistance.

Inquiries regarding the application of the laws or regulations prohibiting gender discrimination in education shall be directed to the Superintendent of Schools.

Any complaint of an alleged violation of Title IX shall be forwarded in writing to the Superintendent of Schools or designated delegate. The Superintendent or designated delegate shall promptly investigate the alleged violation, determine validity of complaint, and take corrective action. If the complaint is against the Superintendent of Schools, the complaint shall be forwarded to the School Attorney, who will promptly investigate the alleged violation, and take corrective action if necessary. In the event that an alleged violation requires action by the Board of Education, the Superintendent or School Attorney shall bring the matter to the Board within 45 days of the receipt of a complaint. The Board of Education shall act promptly on any alleged violations. This complaint procedure shall be available to any employee or student.

The complainant may proceed with further appeal to the U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare, the Office of Civil Rights, or to the New York State Division of Human Rights Office.
