**SCHOOL ADMISSIONS: STUDENTS RESIDING WITH PEOPLE
OTHER THAN PARENTS, LEGAL GUARDIANS, FOSTER PARENTS**

The Board of Education is required to provide an educational program without tuition charges for children residing in the school district.

To be a resident, a child must have his or her only actual residence in this school district. A child's residency is presumed by law to be that of his parent or legal guardian, or the home in which he or she has been placed by a social agency.

It is the policy of the Board of Education to charge tuition to all children seeking to enroll, but who are not residents of the Town of Webb Union Free School District. Anyone who wants to enroll a child living with them must overcome the presumption that the child is not a resident or have appropriate reasons to be classified as homeless.

Therefore, the Board reserves the right to require an affidavit of residency from all relatives or other adults who seek to enroll a child living with them. The affidavit requires a sworn statement that this is the child's actual and only residence, and that the adult has complete and sole responsibility, legal and financial, for the child.
