

**STUDENT ATTENDANCE:  
ADMISSION OF EMANCIPATED MINORS**

A student between 16 and 18 years of age, who can show that he/she lives independent of parental control or financial support will be designated an emancipated minor. Such a student who wants to attend the Town of Webb Union Free Schools without paying tuition must prove that he/she is emancipated and a resident of the district.

The district may require any or all of the following documentation each year:

1. Proof of Residence:
  - 1.1 If residence is rented, a statement from the landlord stating the name of the minor as the tenant, and a rent receipt in the minor's name.
  - 1.2 If residence is owned, a copy of the deed.
2. Proof of Financial Independence:
  - 2.1 A letter from the employer stating the salary and hours worked per week.
  - 2.2 A statement of other financial means.
3. Completion of a sworn Affidavit of Emancipation

If at any time the above information is changed without prompt notification or proven to be false, the parent/guardian and/or student shall be subject to tuition charges, and may be dismissed from enrollment.
