RELEASE OF INFORMATION TO THE NONCUSTODIAL PARENT

The District must by law presume that the noncustodial parent has the authority to request information concerning his/her child and the release, upon request, of such information. If the custodial parent wishes to limit the noncustodial parent's access to the records, it is his/her responsibility to obtain and present to the school, a legally binding document which provides for a limitation of such access.
