ADMINISTRATION OF OPIOID OVERDOSE MEDICATION

The Board of Education realizes that the prompt administration of opioid overdose medications to a person who has suffered an opioid overdose potentially can save a life. Accordingly the District shall, in consultation with appropriate agencies and medical personnel (school physician or affiliated MVHS physician), develop a program for maintenance and administration of opioid overdose medication. The District shall include training, storage, and administration as well as implementation guidelines as part of the plan.
