**EXTRA-CURRICULAR ORGANIZATIONS:
STANDARDS FOR APPROVAL**

The Board of Education shall recognize, encourage, and assume the responsibility for supervision of those student organizations which meet the following standards:

1. Serve a worthy educational objective.
2. Have a membership open on a democratic basis to all students qualified and interested in the work of the organization.
3. File its charter with the Principal after its approval by the Board.
4. Have a faculty sponsor acceptable to the Superintendent.
5. Have its finances subject to the rules of the Board of Education.
6. Be subject to any other rules laid down by the district.

The Superintendent shall publish each year for the information of students and parents, a list of approved school organizations, and make it clear that only these organizations are recognized as school organizations. All other youth organizations are non-school groups for which the district accepts no responsibility.
