

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSPORTATION

All of the following distance criteria are to be determined by measuring from the legal residence of the student desiring transportation to the School, using a vehicle operated by a School employee, over the nearest available public route. The point on School property from which distances from home to School are measured is the School building designated loading/unloading area (bus circle). This is the primary arrival and departure point for all students transported to and from School.

1. Students attending grades K-12, who live at least 3/4 mile from School and are within District boundaries, are eligible for transportation.
2. Transportation requiring voter approval - Transportation at distances not required by State law, which if provided becomes an expense to the taxpayers of the District, must have voter approval.
3. Handicapped Students - For children ages 5-21, a recommendation from the Committee on special Education will be submitted to the Board of Education for approval. Transportation for these students will be provided as approved by the Board of Education or required by law. It is expected that parents will be at the home, and trained instructional or non-instructional staff members at the School will be available to assist the children from these points as necessary.
