Homework

Homework, when assigned, will count no more than 10% of a student's overall grade. Completion of homework will be a condition for allowing students to retake assessments.

Late Work

Late work will be accepted without penalty until one calendar week following the original date an assignment is due. Students who are submitting assignments electronically are responsible for notifying the teacher that the assignment has been submitted.

Explanation of Zeroes

Zeroes will be given only for work that is not submitted.

Reassessment

Students who wish to retake any summative assessment will be provided with teacher feedback and given an opportunity to be reassessed one time, either through a retake or by completing an alternate assessment determined by the teacher. Prior to reassessing, students must meet the following conditions: 1) All homework and class assignments must have been submitted and be up-to-date, and 2) students must participate in or complete an intervention/remediation determined by the teacher.

Make-up Work

Following any absence, make up work will be accepted without penalty until one calendar week following the date of the student's return. Teachers will consider timing and length of absences in adjusting this policy as necessary. Students who are submitting assignments electronically are responsible for notifying the teacher that the assignment has been submitted.

Extra Credit

There will be no extra credit assignments offered.
